In consideration of the promises set forth herein, parties agree to the following:

1. Loan. The equipment listed on Exhibit A and/or Exhibit B, attached hereto, is loaned to Customer for the sole purpose of utilizing the equipment for its expressed purpose, as a Public Address system or a Quilt Rack Display System, at the location in accordance with, and during the stated term of this Agreement. CMQHOF agrees to allow Customer to use the Equipment until the Return Date stated below. 2. Term. The term of this Agreement will commence on the Effective Date below and will continue until the day which the CMQHOF requests the return of the Equipment, which is listed below. Customer acknowledges that the CMQHOF may take possession of the Equipment at any time.
3. No Warranty; Limitations of Liability. CMQHOF has not made and does not make any warranty of any kind, express or implied, with respect to the design, operation, or condition of the equipment or any part thereof. CMQHOF shall have no liability to customer for any claim, loss, or damage caused or alleged to be caused by the equipment, or in any way related to or arising out of the agreement.
4. Use, Operation, and Maintenance.
 - a) Customer shall use the Equipment only during the term of this Agreement and only in the manner for which it was designed and intended.
 - b) Customer agrees to promptly give notice to CMQHOF of any loss or damage to the Equipment.
 - c) Customer acknowledges and agrees that the Equipment is being loaned with all risk of use and operation of the Equipment, and that CMQHOF will not be liable to

Customer for the use of the Equipment or damages of any kind resulting from any claimed malfunction of the Equipment.

5. Surrender of Equipment. Upon the Return Date, Customer shall return the Equipment to CMQHOF in good repair, condition, and working order, ordinary wear and tear resulting from ordinary use excepted. Customer assumes responsibility for all damages and/or missing components.
6. Damages. Customer acknowledges that Equipment must be returned to CMQHOF in good working order or will replace damaged Equipment by purchasing new, or provide 100% of the funds to do so to CMQHOF if damage occurs.
